The yearlong celebrations will be concluded in December with a **3 day Golden Jubilee National Welding Seminar** and **Weld India exhibitions**.

The Institute has identified the requirement of skilled personnel for the survival of the Indian Industries growth and sustainability. Keeping this in view we have now directed ourselves to focus on the improvement of the skill levels in the country by closely working with the Government.

It is felt by the industries that graduate level Bachelor Degree courses in Welding engineering need to be introduced in the country in the various Engineering Colleges and the universities. IIW in its mission has set up new Group called "Modular Welding Education System" and are preparing a detailed report and the same will be discussed with the Ministry of HRD, Govt of India and impress the need of this stream as a course in the Engineering colleges. A retired Vice Chancellor of a University has been entrusted this responsibility.

In order to work closely with the Government and with the Industries a Public Relation committee has been introduced and the team will be able to take IIW programs to all parts by proper communications and meeting. We have further strengthened our bond with ISNT another professional Institute. Discussions are on with other institutes like ASM & IIM. The Association of Welding Product Manufacturers (AWPM) and our Institute are working closely to the benefit of welding Industries. Presently we have built a strong relation with CII and with Sector Skill council and we hope to work more closely with these organizations and with Industries to take up the skill development and safety programs to all corners of the country and request the Government to recognize and notify the welding as an important activity and needs proper recognition.
