BELLUR RAMA RAO AWARD

The Council of the Geological Society of India at its recent meeting felt that the local character of 'The Mysore Geologists' Association Award' should be removed and accordingly decided to merge the funds under this head with the newly instituted Bellur Rama Rao Award.

The following rules for the Award are notified for general information:

Rules for the BELLUR RAMA RAO AWARD

1. The Award will be called the 'BELLUR RAMA RAO AWARD', and will consist of a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- and a citation.

2. The Award will be made once in three years to a scientist who has made outstanding contribution to the Precambrian Geology of India.

3. In making the Award, the work done during the previous five years shall be taken into consideration.

4. The first Award will be made in the year 1992.

5. Nomination to the Award can be made any time during the year, furnishing brief bio data of the candidate nominated for the Award, a summary of his main contributions and copies of his important publications during the preceding five years. Papers outlining original research or forming a synthesis of existing knowledge are eligible for consideration.

6. Nominator who should be a Fellow of good standing, should provide his name and full address.

7. Selection will be made by the Executive Council whose decision will be final. It is left to the Council to seek the advice of experts in selecting the candidate for the Award.

8. Last date for the receipt of nominations is **31st December 1991.**
