S. Narayanaswami Award for contributions in the field of Economic Geology.

M.R. Srinivasa Rao Award for outstanding contributions in the field of Petrology.

JGSI-Radhakrishna Prize for the best paper published in the Journal of the Geological Society of India during the year 2005.

S.S. Merh Award for the significant contributions in the field of Quaternary Geology.

K. Naha Award for significant contributions in the field of Structural Geology, Metamorphic Petrology or Precambrian Geology.

H.S. Pareek Award for the best paper published in the Journal of the Geological Society of India in Coal Sciences during the year 2005.

N.N. Chatterjee Award for contributions in the field of Energy Resources.

5. Brief statement by the proposer (not more than 300 words) about the scientific achievements of the nominee to justify the award.
