

A CONTRIBUTION TO THE BOTANY OF ORISSA

ABSTRACT

This paper presents the essential features of geology, topography, soil, climate, vegetation and floristic composition of the tropical deciduous and tropical semi-evergreen/evergreen forests occurring in parts of Cuttack district, Keonjhar district, Mayurbhanja district and Bolangir-Sambalpur districts of Orissa. An enumeration of about 868 species of angiosperms, gymnosperms, pteridophytes and fungi representing 1845 field numbers collected between 1957-1959 is appended. It includes 34 species and ten genera found as new records for Bihar and Orissa and 60 species found as new records for Orissa only.

While describing 183 species of angiosperms and ferns as new records for Orissa, Mooney (1950) in his Supplement to Haines' (1921-1925) Botany of Bihar and Orissa cited a few localities as virtually unexplored botanically and recommended their exploration not only for botanising the areas concerned but for discovering additional new records of species for Orissa. In pursuance of a well-planned 5 years programme of work emphasising botanical survey of the unexplored and under-explored regions in Eastern India (cf. Rao and Panigrahi 1959) and bearing in mind Mooney's suggestions on the subject, three botanical exploration tours were undertaken by the senior author

between 1957-1959 in the forest tracts of the Rebna Reserve Forest (bordering upon Meghanada Parbat, 1053 m) in the Keonjhar district, of the Simlipal Reserve Forest (bordering upon Meghasini Peak, 1250 m) in the Mayurbhanja district and the Reserve Forest in the Gandhamardan Parbat (975 m) forming the boundary between Sambalpur and Bolangir districts of Orissa.

The details of the localities surveyed, periods of visit, duration of visit, and the total field numbers of species collected in each of these tours are tabulated in the Table I and the exact route followed and the localities surveyed are indicated in the Map below.



While the first two tours undertaken entirely at our own initiative, the timing of the third tour to the Gandhamardan Hills was expedited and decided upon at the request of the Orissa State Government to explore the rich indigenous medicinal plants of the Gandhamardan Hills of the "Ramayana" epic fame.

Although the three exploration tours were undertaken in three different years in five different districts of Orissa, the whole area covered may be taken as constituting a single phytogeographical unit with similar vegetation types and floristic compositions. This paper, therefore, summarises all available data on topography, vegetation and floristic composition of the areas covered, together with a critical analysis of the species distribution both within and without Orissa. Enumeration of the species of angiosperms, gymnosperms, ferns and fungi is appended together with the collection numbers, locality, important notes on habitat abundance and flowering and fruiting seasons for each species.

GEOLOGY, TOPOGRAPHY AND SOIL

Geologically speaking, Meghanada Parbat in the Keonjhar district, Simlipal hills in the Mayurbhanja district as also the Gandhamardan ranges in the borders of the Sambalpur-Bolangir districts, belong to the southern tract, one of the three topographical divisions to which Bihar and Orissa is conveniently divided (cf. Haines 1925). It contains a confused and broken mountain system, only a small part of which is in direct connection with the Central table land. The hills of Sukinda Anchal (100 m), Rebna (300 m), Atai (350 m), Gandhamardan (1000 m) attain the highest point in Meghapada Parbat (1053 m), whereas the Simlipal hills represent a compact block of mountain system ranging between 300 m to 1250 m, the highest being attained at Meghasini (1250 m). Similarly, the Gandhamardan ranges delimited by Borasambar, Malda, Paikmal and Manbhanga in the north and Amarakhola-Batipathar-Brahmini-Harishankar and Chandil in the south comprise of low undulating hills ranging from 220 m to 1060 m, the highest point being attained at the "Satyamba Pat". Pyramidal mounds are frequent in Bolangir area. The high plateau consists of gneiss with lateritic caps. The entire hills ranges except Gandhamardan Parbat referred to above lie north of the Mahanadi river and essentially comprise of Dharwar formation and typically consist of shales, phyllites, haematite and other iron schists with quartz veins, siliceous clay slates, quartzites or hard sand stones which are very wide-spread. Exposures of archaen gneiss are frequent towards the northern boundary. Haematite, chromite and granite are available in low mountains and steep hills in Malyagiri and Keonjhar areas. The soils in the Gandhamardan ranges are derived from metamorphic rocks, called "Khandaite" and contain quartz schists, flakes of aluminium naer Batipathar and graphite at Harishankar. Reddish brown lateritic caps and ferruginous clays cover the hills and "Pat" which is a flat plain of about 1½ miles broad at Satyamba Pat. Black cotton soil and lateritic soils of high fertility occur in the foot hills, plains and valleys. China clay is met with in Karanjia.

The Keonjhar district is beset with rivers, like Baitarani, Musal and Kosai (the last one originating from Meghanada Parbat) whereas the Simlipal hills are traversed by Burhabalang, Palpala, Bandan and Korai. Perennial streams like Brahmini, Kapildhar, Suktal and Harishankar flow down the hills of the Gandhamardan range cutting their way through hard core of gneiss. Water of the Suktal river near Harishankar is of pH 7.3 and is, therefore, alkaline. There is one hot spring at Mokabari, 4 miles from Simlipalgarh where water is bubbling up in the bed of one rice field. There is a big water fall at Barheipani, which runs down 1308 ft through naked bare rocks in two stages, one upper flat horizontal portion and the second vertical fall. There is a rivulet running through the valley, which is covered with evergreen forest.

CLIMATE

The areas enjoy a typical monsoon climate with variations in annual rainfall as given below:

Harishankar 2200 mm

Keonjhar (Sukinda) 1000-1250 mm

Sambalpur (Borasambar) 1250-1500 mm

Baripada (Simlipal) 1500-2000 mm

During these three tours the scanty temperature and relative humidity data collected are in agreement with the climatic pattern referred to above. The average maximum temperature at Sukinda in June, 1957 was 28°C with 83% relative humidity (on 21.6.57 maximum temperature was 37°C with 51% relative humidity). At Simlipalgarh maximum temperature was 23°.3°C and minimum 10°.5°C and the relative humidity was 34% during the day but 84% at night, these striking differences being due to heavy frost at night in the area in February. At Gandhamardan Parbat the maximum temperature was 30°.5°C with 88% relative humidity on 3.11.1959 although in May temperature goes upto 40°C.

VEGETATION

Consistent with the climatic and biotic factors operating in the region, the forests of Rebna, Simlipal and Gandhamardan areas explored, present 2 or 3 stages of succession.

SUKINDA-REBNA-KEONJHARGARH FORESTS

(a) The vegetation of Sukinda Anchal forests may be classified as TROPICAL DRY DECIDUOUS FOREST (Rao & Panigrahi 1961) with *Shorea-Terminalia-Diospyros* association. *Shorea robusta* Gaertn. f. is the predominant element in

open areas and on flat ridges of hills associated with *Terminalia tomentosa* (Sahaj or Asana-Oriya), *T. arjuna*, *Diospyros melanoxylon* (Kendu-Oriya),

Anogeissus latifolia, *Madhuca indica*, *Aegle marmelos* and *Adina cordifolia* (Halanda-Oriya), *Syzygium cumini* etc. Large number of thorny species viz. *Meyna laxiflora*, *Flacourtie cataphracta*, etc. are met with on the hill slopes.

(b) SEMI-EVERGREEN TYPE is met with in Atai Reserve, on Gandhamardan range near Keonjhargarh and Malyagiri Reserve near Pallahara whereas the forests near Banguru (900 m) on the belt of Meghanada Parbat almost borders upon tropical evergreen type. *Xylia-Callicarpa-Polyalthia* association with *Xylia xylocarpa*, *Callicarpa arborea*, *Polyalthia cerasoides* are associated with *Garcinia cowa*, *Pittosporum floribundum*, *Miliusa velutina*, *Strychnos potatorum*, *Protium serratum*, *Dillenia aurea* and *Ficus* spp., form closed associations in moist-laden hills often giving the physiognomy of evergreen type. Several species like *Zizyphus rugosa*, *Casearia tomentosa*, *Woodfordia fruticosa*, *Millettia auriculata*, *Meyna laxiflora*, *Barringtonia acutangula*, *Grewia aspera*, *Ixora parviflora*, *Wendlandia tinctoria* frequently occur as shrubs in the middle layer whereas *Celastrus paniculata*, *Randia fasciculata*, *Bauhinia vahlii*, *Passiflora foetida* and *Gnetum ulm*, etc. are present as climbers and lianes.

In addition to a rich herbaceous flora in the forest floor the epiphytic flora comprise of orchids viz. *Dendrobium herbaceum*, *D. crepidatum*, *Aerides multiflorum*, *A. odoratum*, *Rhyncostylis retusa* and of a few ferns and Piperaceae in the humid spots along the beds of streams and in sheltered valleys.

SIMLIPAL FOREST

Simlipal Reserve Forest of Mayurbhanja district comprising of a single compact block extends over about 1100 square miles. It represents a virgin semi-evergreen forest which expresses the climatic climax type of vegetation. The central core of the forest covers the ridges and valley of the hills and is yet undisturbed by any biotic factor. The forest growth is thick and impenetrable and is dominated by gigantic growth of a large number of tree species the chief amongst which is *Shorea robusta* Gaertn. f.

The region explored being rather vast (1100 sq. miles) and the altitudes covered being variable (30-1000 m) the semi-evergreen forest referred to above represents different facets of the vegetation from dry deciduous type with a number of xerophytic species accompanied by stunted growth of sal in areas adjoining Simlipalgarh Nigirda-Lulung section to mixed deciduous forest or semi-evergreen type over most of the areas of this forest. At times it borders upon the evergreen forest type found in pockets in the deep moist valleys on the way to Bhanjabasa and Meghasini and again at the Barheipani Falls and along the banks of the

Palpala river near Kachudahan. Depending upon the respective region the dominant sal species sometimes forms almost compact pure stands such as in the Karanjia-Gurguria sector of the Simlipal forest. But over the greater part of this forest area, the sal species may be classed to have a number of co-dominants or important species such as *Anogeissus latifolia*, *Terminalia tomentosa*, *Pterocarpus marsupium*, *Ougeinia dalbergioides*, *Syzygium jambolana*, *Michelia champaca*, *Dillenia aurea*, *Diospyros peregrina*, *Adina cordifolia*, *Schleichera oleosa*, *Bauhinia* spp. etc., this association of gigantic trees being more prominent in the Barhepani-Chahala-Talbandha area. In the Simlipalgarh area, however, although the sal forms almost pure stands, the vegetation is rather xeromorphic in type. Sal is of stunted growth standing on bare lateritic rock surfaces of hills, the ground vegetation being mostly a thick closely-set cover of *Phoenix acaulis*, which grows with sal saplings and grasses with an approach to thorn scrub aspect with *Flacourtie* sp., *Capparis zeylanica* and *Zizyphus*. Along the banks of rivers traversing the area, *Salix tetrasperma*, *Syzygium jambolana*, *Homoñoia riparia* and *Hypericum* sp. among the trees and shrubs occur along with ferns viz. *Cyathea* spp., *Angiopteris evecta* and very many species of *Cyclosorus* and *Thelypteris*. Besides, shrubs viz., *Randia* sp., *Gardenia* sp., *Glochidion* and *Cleistanthus collinus* as also *Indigofera pulchella* (commonest under shrub with purple-pink flowers) forms the second storey in the forest associated with young plants of the tree species at various stages of development. Among the climbers and lianes *Bauhinia vahlii*, *Mucuna pruriata*, *Gnetum ula*, *Millettia auriculata* together with *Ventilago calycinata* are the most important species at times giving a nettled appearance to the middle layer of the forest. Among the ground vegetation, a large number of Acanthaceae, Leguminosae and Labiateae are the commonest flowering species in altitudes between 300-1000 m. Among the epiphytes various species of orchids such as *Dendrobium*, *Oberonia*, *Vanda*, etc. are common in the forests of Bhanjabasa and Jenabil whereas *Luisia* is perhaps the only surviving orchid in the dry deciduous forests of Simlipal, Nigirda-Dudruchampa area. A few mosses and a small number of epiphytic ferns are found in February which is rather dry.

Below this altitude, however, sal is associated with *Diospyros melanoxylon*, *Terminalia arjuna*, *T. tomentosa*, *Madhuca indica*, *Schleichera oleosa* and *Ficus bengalensis* and a few other species of *Ficus*, *Butea monosperma* and *Woodfordia fruticosa* with their radiant glow of purple red flowers as also the crimson red young leaves of *Schleichera oleosa* colour the lower altitudes. *Melia composita* and *Mangifera indica* are also common in the lower altitudes along with a climber, *Combre-*

tum decandrum which covers tops of many trees and shrubs in the month of February.

GANDHAMARDAN PARBAT

The Gandhamardan ranges comprise of undulating hills and valleys with steep northern and southern slopes and represent four different types of vegetation between foot-hills (30 m) and the flat Pat (1000 m).

(1) **Dry deciduous forest**: Tracts of exposed hills near Harishankar and low hills of Malda and Bati-pathar are of secondary type due mainly to human interference. Sal is associated with various species of *Terminalia*, *Pterocarpus marsupium* (*Bija-Oriya*), *Madhuca indica* (*Mahua-Oriya*), *Anogeissus latifolia* (*Dhaura-Oriya*), *Chloroxylon swietenia* (*Bheru-Oriya*), *Bridelia retusa* (*Khaisa-Oriya*) and *Cleistanthus collinus* (*Karada-Oriya*) with a shrubby layer of *Zizyphus oenoplia*, *Helicteres isora*, *Grewia hirsuta*, *Holarrhena antidysenterica*, *Trimfetta bartramia*, *T. rotundifolia* and *T. pilosa*. The middle layer often presents a tangled mass with twining stems of lianes and climbers comprising of *Mucuna pruriata*, *Ampelocissus indica*, *Cissus repanda*, *Dioscorea anguina*, *D. hamiltonii*, etc.

(2) **Bamboo forest**: From the base of hills upto 700 m the dominant bamboo *Dendrocalamus strictus* Nees forms a consociates with a few deciduous elements viz., *Albizia procera*, *Shorea robusta*, *Diospyros melanoxylon*, *Chloroxylon swietenia*, *Lagerstroemia parviflora*, *Pterocarpus marsupium*, *Anogeissus latifolia* and *Terminalia* spp. The middle storey comprises of a shrubby layer with *Holarrhena antidysenterica* and *Helicteres isora* whereas the ground layer comprises mainly of *Trimfetta pilosa*, *Hedychium* spp., *Costus speciosus*, *Curculigo orchipoidea*, *Asparagus racemosus* and *Amorphophallus campanulatus*.

(3) **Semi-evergreen forest**: Although dry deciduous type characterises the plains and foothills and Bamboo forest ascends upto 700 m, the high altitudes from 700 m. 900 m as also the valley in Bati-pathar-Amarakhol-Borasambar-Kapildhar areas present the physiognomy of evergreen type with thick growth of lianes covering the trees having buttressed trunks. The chief tree components of this formation are *Diospyros peregrina* (=*D. embryopteris*), *Mangifera indica* (wild mango), *Careya arborea*, *Mitragyna parviflora* (*Haladu-Oriya*), *Alstonia scholaris* mixed with *Murraya paniculata*, *Ardisia solanacea*, *Maesa indica* and *Antidesma diandrum* among the shrubs and *Millettia* and *Mucuna*, etc., among climbers. It occurs all along the course of streams upto the highest altitude (900 m).

GRASSLANDS

The extensive flat plateau running through the whole length of the Gandhamardan range presents a grassland formation with luxuriant growth of

various grass species attaining 2-3 m in height. The grassland comprises of *Cymbopogon martinii*, *Themeda laxa*, *Heteropogon contortus*, *Arthraxon lanatifolius*, *Microstegium petiolare*, *Chrysopogon lancearius*, *Capillipedium assimile* and is interspersed with stunted growth of *Lagerstroemia parviflora*, *Terminalia tomentosa*, *Pterocarpus marsupium*, *Woodfordia fruticosa*, *Albizia odoratissima*, *Terminalia tomentosa*, *Acacia catechu*, *Emblica officinalis*, *Bauhinia vahlii*, *Pimpinella hexaneana* and *Peucedanum nagpurensis* (*Bansigopal-Oriya*). The exposed haemite rock surface with hardly any soil cover at places is inhabited by *Polycarpea aurea* and *Cyanotis fasciculata* and a stunted grass *Dimeria connivens* which may be used for filling mattress etc. *Dendrobium herbaceum* is the only leafless orchid constituting the epiphytic flora on the Pat' and grows on *Pterocarpus marsupium*.

The low foot hills denuded of forest species and made up with alluvial soils is covered over by *Pogostemon plectranthoides* and grasses amongst which *Brachiaria reptans*, *Dicanthium annulatum*, *Heteropogon contortus*, *Apluda mutica* and *Themeda laxa*, *Eragrostis nutans*, *E. unioloides*, *Chrysopogon aciculatus*, *Ischaemum indicum*, *Echinochloa colonum*, *Paspalum scrobiculatum* (cultivated) are the more important species. Weeds such as *Mollugo pentaphylla*, *Lochnera pusilla*, *Cleome monophylla*, *Chrozophora prostrata*, *Borreria stricta*, etc. are common. *Celosia argentea* (introduced) is a weed of great nuisance in the abandoned fields near Borasambar, Paikmal and Harishankar.

The low-lying lands, on the other hand, comprising of tanks, ditches and swamps in the area are characterised by a lowland community consisting of hydrophytic species in permanent pools or swamps but of a hygrophytic flora in the borders of pools and dried up muddy places. The chief components of the lowland community are enumerated below:

HYDROPHYTEs :

Aeschynomene indica, *Blyxa echinosperma*, *Ceratophyllum demersum*, *Chara* sp., *Hydrilla verticillata*, *Nechamandra alternifolia*, *Neptunia oleracea*, *Nymphaea pubescens*, *N. stellata*, *Ottelia alismoides*, *Potamogeton nodosus*, *Sagittaria guayanensis*, *Scirpus squarrosum*, *Tenagogcharis latifolia*, *Utricularia stellaris*, *Vallisneria spiralis*.

HYGROPHYTEs :

Alocasia fornicata, *Ammania caudata*, *Asteracantha longifolia*, *Caesulia axillaris*, *Coix lacryma-jobi*, *C. aquatica*, *Cyanotis axillaris*, *Eriocaulon quinquangulare*, *Eulalia trispicata*, *Ipomoea aquatica*, *Isoetes coromandelina* (Padampur only), *Limnophylla indica*, *Ludwigia parviflora*, *Monochoria vaginalis*, *Polygonum glabrum*, *Sphaeranthus indicus*.

MEADOW VEGETATION :

Alternanthera sessilis, *Eclipta alba*, *Eragrostis unioloides*, *Evolvulus nummularius*, *Gisekia pharnaceoides*, *Polygonum hydropiper* var. *flaccidum*, *P. glabrum*, *Sachharum spontaneum*.

NEW RECORDS

It is significant to note that despite the reconnaissance nature of the tours undertaken in these three areas 94 species turned out as new records for Orissa only and 34 species both for Bihar and Orissa and two species viz. *Calanthe diploxyphion* Hk. f. and *Asplenium perakense* Matt. and Chr. for India. Additional data on distribution for 19 species out of the 183 species reported by Mooney (1950) as new records for Orissa, were also gathered from these areas visited by us. *Calanthe*, *Cyathula*, *Eryngium*, *Heterostemma*, *Pericampylus* amongst the angiosperms and *Coniogramme* and *Isoetes* amongst the Pteridophytes turned up as new records of genera for Bihar and Orissa. Again, *Angelonia*, *Osyris* and *Cryptomeria* are three new records of genera introduced as cultivated species to Orissa.

FLORISTIC ANALYSIS

A comparative study of the list of species collected reveals slight variation in the respective positions of the ten dominant families of our list with those of Mooney (1950). Total number of angiosperm species described both by Haines (1924-1935) and Mooney (1950) for Bihar and Orissa is 2700 species. Our collections numbering 770 species of angiosperms, therefore, forms a significant sample of the total flora of Bihar and Orissa. Despite variation in respective positions, the dominance of the 10 major families reported by them finds corroboration from our studies also. The variation in species content reflected in our three independent collections made in June-July, October-November and February, may be accounted for by the seasonal differences controlling the development of the annual herbaceous flora. The ten dominant families represented in our collections are: Gramineae (49G-81 spp.), Leguminosae (41G-81 spp.), Euphorbiaceae (22G-38 spp.), Acanthaceae (19G-37 spp.), Compositae (25G-35 spp.), Rubiaceae (23G-32 spp.), Cyperaceae (9G-31 spp.), Orchidaceae (15G-25 spp.), Malvaceae (9G-20 spp.) and Aspidiaceae (7G-23 spp.). Of these, eight families excluding Aspidiaceae, Malvaceae are also listed by Mooney as the ten dominant families in the flora of India, the other two families in order of dominance being Labiateae and Urticaceae. These two families, however, are represented by 15 spp. and 17 spp. respectively in our collections.

Accordingly, the tabular presentation of the floristic data for Bihar and Orissa (cf. Mooney 1950, pp. 16 & 245) is modified as follows:

Thus the total number of genera has risen from 1123 to 1130 and the species from 2700 to 2730.

DISTRIBUTION

An analysis of the distributional range of the species collected from Orissa and enumerated in the list enclosed brings out the following interesting data on their phytogeographical relationships. *Aeschynomene indica*, *Borreria stricta*, *Desmodium motorium*, *Rubus ellipticus* and *Sphaeranthus indicus* have a greater range of distribution extending from Kashmir to Assam in the north and Ceylon in the south, while *Canthium dicoccum*, *Cyathula prostrata*, *Diospyros montana*, *Hypericum japonicum*, *Melosma simplicifolia*, *Micromelum integrerrimum*, *Moghania strobilifera* and *Shuteria vestita* are common to Ceylon, Orissa and Assam Himalayas but are absent from Kashmir. Similarly, *Garcinia cowa*, *Microstylis congesta* are common to Orissa, Andamans and Khasia hills and *Gnaphalium luteo-album* and *Datura stramonium* are common to Assam, Orissa and Kashmir, but *Cephalostigma hirsutum* though found in Orissa, is absent from Assam. Again, only one species viz. *Dillenia aurea* extends its range to Andamans on the south east and Himalayas on the north, but *Harpullia arborea* and *Peltophorum pterocarpum* found in Ceylon and Andamans, have their northernly range limited by Orissa only.

Of the six endemics described by Haines for Orissa *Hypericum gaitii* Haines has now been collected from Nowna forest of Simlipalgarh at an altitude of 300 m.

RARE AND INTERESTING SPECIES

The road from Balasore to Baripada and again between Baripada to Podadiha is lined up, as it were, by pure stands of Sal, which provide a natural avenue of great interest.

Whereas bamboos are very uncommon and do not occur indigenously in the Simlipal forest (although a few introduced species are doing well in the vicinity of the villages and at Dukura, several clumps of *Dendrocalamus strictus* were in flower, *D. strictus* is the principal forest product of the Gandhamardan hills and serve as feeders to the Bengal Paper Mills Ltd., Calcutta, who maintain an Office, Godown and Experimental Station at Harishankar).

Various epiphytic orchids such as *Dendrobium*, *Vanda*, *Oberonia*, etc. are common in the forests of Bhanjabasa, Palaspal, Jenabil and Rebna Reserve

Forests whereas Luisia is perhaps the only surviving orchid in the dry deciduous forests of Simlipal, Nigirda-Dudruchampa area. *Vanda tessellata* is almost a weedy paste on all trees in Sukinda area. *Gnetum ula* occurs extensively as a liana on the way to Jenabil and to Banguru and *Salix tetrasperma* and *Homonoia riparia* along the course of rivers in the Simlipal area.

Eranthemum nervosum with its blue violet flowers and showy strobili-like bracts having whitish margin occurs in shady ravines throughout the Simlipal forest. Similarly, the tree fern *Cyathea* sp. with *Angiopteris evecta* occur along the stream near Nigirda, on the way to Dudruchampa and in other wet situations. *Cylosorus interruptus* (Willd.) Ching mixed with *Pteridium aculeatum* (L.) Kuhn forms extensive patches mixed with *Themeda laxa* A. Camus in open sunny situations at Bhanjabasa (2600 ft) whereas *Abacopteris multilineata* (Wall.) Ching—the most weedy fern species occurs in almost all shady humid situations throughout the whole range of Simlipal forest.

The insectivorous plant *Drosera burmanni* is found from Gurguria to Jenabil, *Dendrophthoe falcata* (= *Loranthus longiflorus*) which attracts attention with its reddish green flowers growing as a hemi-parasite on Sal and *Madhuca* in the plains, becomes rarer between 600 to 900 m, *Cassytha filiformis* which resembles *Cuscuta reflexa* in habit, is rather uncommon in Sukinda area only. *Alectra thomsoni* a root parasite found near Satyamba and again at Harishankar is a species of great medicinal value.




Fig. 2. *Stychnos nux-vomica* Linn.

Occasionally, a few rare species are met with. At Dukura, one giant tree of *Strychnos nux-vomica* studded with ripe orange yellow fruits borne on leafless branches (Fig. 2) drew our immediate attention. After Taramara, 26 miles from Podadiha and again at Lulung, *Agave sessiliflora* Perr. ex Engl. with pale yellow spiny leaves and with flowers and bulbils borne on majestic pole-like peduncles provide an interesting change to the monotonous sal-forest in the area. *Cycas circinalis*, only one plant, is seen along the road from Podadiha to Dongadiha at 366 m although it is common in Sukinda and Ghatgaon areas. Similarly, a few plants of *Cochlospermum religiosum* with bright yellow attractive flowers are seen in the forest along the road sides at Bangriposi in the Mayurbhanja district, although it is very common in the forests south of Harishankar in the Bolangir district. *Podostemon wallichii* grows extensively on rock boulders and pebbles in the bed of swift-flowing Koroi river near Gurguria. *Isoetes coromandelina* form a big patch near the margin of a tank in front of Padampur I. B. and is a new record for Orissa. *Lycopodium squarrosum* Forst. with its drooping stems occurs in sheltered valleys with other epiphytes viz., orchids and ferns, whereas

Fomes pachyphaleus with its successively branched chocolate fruit-bodies on living sal tree and *Hexagonia sulcata* with its honey-comb-like hymenium offer interesting sights.

At Lulung (167 m), 13 miles from Baripada the Forest Dept. is maintaining a survey of *Rauvolfia serpentina* over 3-4 acres of land and the total number of plants would now be of the order of 10,000 or so. The interesting point about this survey is that although *Rauvolfia* is rare in the wild state in this jungle, plants occurring sporadically in nature in the Simlipal Forest have been collected and planted at Lulung where further propagation is from the seeds whose percentage of germination is rather low. 32 miles from Keonjargarh towards Telkoi, *R. serpentina* is common in scattered patches.

Cymbopogon martinii (Rosha grass) on the other hand, occurs in commercial quantities on the Satyamba "Pat" and may be exploited by the State Govt. for establishing a factory for the distillation of the famous essential oil, "Rosha grass oil", whose principal constituent is geraniol and which is used by Indian manufacturers in blending perfumes to the soaps and toilets.

Amongst introduced species *Pinus insularis* (= *Pinus khasya*), *Grevillea robusta* and *Eucalyptus* sp. are doing very well in the forests of Dudruchampa. *Eucalyptus* trees stand majestically in front of the Chahala I. B. whereas at Kachudahan, *Santalum album* and *Pinus insularis* also are doing well. About half a dozen plants of *Cryptomeria japonica* introduced to Dudruchampa are yet struggling for survival whereas in the same place *Pinus*

insularis planted originally over 40 acres of land, would now number to about 6000 plant.

Ampelopteris prolifera (Retz.) Copel. (= *Goniopteris prolifera* Retz.). 12400 Gurguria, 12505 Simlipal, frequent in black alluvium; fertile: February.

Cyclosorus acuminatus (Houtt.) Ching (= *Nephrodium molle* Desv.). (H 1186). 8613 Bankura, occasional in black loam; fertile: July.

C. callosus (Blume) Copel. 8698 Baitarani source-Keonjhargarh, occasional in dry rocky crevices; fertile: February.

C. dentatus (Forsk.) Ching. 12395 Gurguria, 12521 Simlipal, 12638 Burhabalang, 20758 Batipathar, 20820 Mahadevjhara, common near water edge; fertile: February.

C. gongyloides (Schkuhr.) Link. (= *Dryopteris gongyloides* O. Ktze.). (M 217). 21086 Harishankar, frequent in marshy, swampy places; fertile: November.

C. interruptus (Willd.) Ching. (= *D. pteroides* O. Ktze.). (M 217). 12260 Bhanjabasa, 12679 Barheipani, occasional, plants in the shelter of old tree trunks in open sunny ground on humus covered soil; fertile: February.

C. megaphyllus (Mett.) Ching. 12564 Nigirda, frequent in crevices of rock boulders and also in shady swampy places; fertile: February—July.

C. parasiticus (Linn.) Farwell (= *Nephrodium molle* Desv.). (H 1186). 8610 Palaspal, frequent in moist shady places; fertile: February—July.

C. sagittifolius (Blume) Copel. 8668 Burhipada, 12573 Nigirda, 21020 Kapildhar, occasional in the humus covered soil; fertile: July.

C. subpubescens (Blume) Ching non sensu Ching (= *Nephrodium molle* Desv.). (H 1186). 12534 Bankura, 12080 Brahmini, 20827 Mahadevjhara, occasional in the shelter of rock boulders; fertile: February.

C. truncatus (Poir.) Farwell. 8609 Palaspal, occasional; fertile: July.

Diplazium dilatatum Blume (= *D. latifolium* Moore). 12331 Bhanjabasa, 12736 Lulung, common in leafy litter; fertile: July.

D. esculentum (Retz.) Swartz (= *Anisogonium esculentum* Presl). 12405 Jenabil, 12736 Lulung, common in crevices of rock boulders, in the banks of running streams; fertile: February.

D. polypodioides Blume. 12526 Simlipalgarh, frequent in the shade next to stream; fertile: February. New record for Bihar and Orissa.

Dryopteris cochlearia (Don.) C. Chr. (M 218). 8753 Gandhamardan Parbat, 12289 Bhanjabasa, 12404 Gurguria, 20826 Mahadevjhara, 21018 Kapildhar,

- common in rocky wall, fertile: February—November (*Bada-Mahajal*).
Dryopteris sparsa (Don.) O. Kze. (M 218). 12597 Nigirda, occasional in sandy soil, next to a stream; fertile: February.
Heterogramme saxicolum (Blume) Holtt. (= *Pleocnemis megalocarpa* Hook.). 8611 Bankura, 12263 Bhanjabasa, 12410 Gurguria, common in humid valleys; fertile: February—July.
Byrsopteris aristata (Forst.) Morton (= *Lastrea aristata* Bedd.). 12596 Nigirda, frequent, along bank of river; fertile: February. New record for Bihar and Orissa.
Thelypteris ciliata (Wall.) Ching (= *Lastrea calcarata* Blume var. *ciliata* Wall.). 12397 Gurguria, frequent; fertile: February.
T. extensa (Blume) Morton (= *Nephrodium extensum* Moore). 12396 Gurguria, 12533 Simlipal, common in rocky soil on forest floor; fertile: February.
T. falculoba (Hook.) Ching (= *L. calcarata* var. *falciloba* Clarke). (H 1191). 12624 Burhabalang, frequent, along the bank of stream; fertile: February.
T. multilineata (Wallich ex Hook.) Morton (= *Dryopteris moulmeinensis* C. Chr.). (M 217). 8612 Bankura, 12262 Chahala, common in shady forest floor; vegetative: February—July.
T. unita (Linn.) Morton (= *Nephrodium cucullatum* Baker). 12398 Gurguria, 12401 Jenabil, 12505 Bankura, 12626 Burhabalang, common in moist alluvium soil; fertile: February.

BLECHNACEAE

- Blechnum orientale** Linn. (M 220). 12406 Gurguria, 12560 Nigirda, 20944 Satyamba, frequent in shelter of river bank; fertile: November—February (*Rakta-mahajal*).

- Woodwardia radicans** (Linn.) Smith. 20804a Batipathar, occasional in crevices of rocks; fertile: November. New record for Bihar and Orissa.

ASPLENIACEAE

- Asplenium laciniatum** var. *depauparatum* Clarke (H 1196). 12310 Bhanjabasa, occasional on mossy bark; epiphytic, fertile: February. New record for Orissa.

- A. perakense** Mathew and Christ. 8653 Bankura, 12411 Gurguria, frequent on mossy bark, epiphytic; fertile: February—July. New record for India.

POLYPODIACEAE

- Drynaria quercifolia** (Linn.) J. Smith (H 224). 8428 Ghatgaon, 8731 Keonjhargarh, occasional; epiphytic on marble rock boulders, fertile: June—July.

- Lepisorus nudus** (Hook.) Ching (= *Pleopeltis linearis* Moore). (H 1205). 8645 Bankura, frequent, epiphytic on mossy trees; fertile: February—July.

L. thunbergianus (Kaulf.) Ching (= *P. linearis* Moore). (H 1205). 12253 Podadiha, 12280 Bhanjabasa, frequent, epiphytic on mossy bark of trees; fertile: February.

Leptochilus decurrens Blume (= *Gymnopteris variabilis* Bedd.). 8614 Bankura, 12506 Simlipalgarh, frequent, adhering to wet boulders; fertile: February.

Microsorum membranaceum (Don.) Ching (= *Polyodium membranaceum* Don.). (M 223). 20935b Kapildhar, occasional on mossy covered rocks and boulders; vegetative: November.

M. punctatum (Linn.) Copel. 8615 Bankura, 12291 Bhanjabasa, frequent, epiphytic on mossy bark of trees; fertile: February—July.

Pyrrosia adnascens (Swartz) Ching (= *Cyclophorus adnascens* Desv.). (M 223). 8471 Rebna, frequent, epiphytic on trees; fertile: June.

P. stigmosa (Swartz) Ching (= *C. stigmosus* Desr.). (M 224). 8592 Meghanada Parbat, common, epiphytic on trees; fertile: July.

VITTARIACEAE

Antrophyum reticulatum (Forst.) Kaulf. 12284 Bhanjabasa, 12416 Jenabil, epiphytic on mossy bark of trees, in sheltered valleys; fertile: February.

MARSILEACEAE

Marsilea quadrifolia Linn. (H 1218). 8388 Deogaon, frequent, in marshy places; vegetative: June.

M. minuta Linn. (H 1218). 8262 Sukinda, 2056r Padampur, common in wet muddy soil; fertile: November.

EQUISETACEAE

Equisetum debile Roxb. (M 227). 12415 Gurguria, common, in sandy bank of river; fertile: February.

SELAGINELLACEAE

Selaginella repanda (Desv.) Spring (M 228). 20658 Batipathar, 20712 Bhojpurgarh, frequent on moist soil, on rock boulders in shady places; fertile: November.

S. subdiaphana (Wall.) Spring. 12538 Bankura, frequent in the bank of stream; fertile: February. New record for Bihar and Orissa.

S. ciliaris (Retz.) Spring (M 228). 12706 Barhepani, occasional in muddy places; fertile: February.

LYCOPODIACEAE

Lycopodium cernuum Linn. (M 227). 12582 Nigirda, frequent; creeping on brown soil; fertile: February.

L. hamiltonii Forst. (H 1221). 12312 Bhanjabasa, 12429 Jenabil, frequent, on mossy bark of trees; epiphytic, fertile: February.

L. squarrosum Forst. (H 1221). 12312 Bhanjabasa, frequent, epiphytic on mossy bark of trees; fertile: February.

ISOETACEAE

Isoetes coromandelina Linn. 20553 Padampur, common in the muddy bank of the tank in front of I. B.; fertile; November. New record for Bihar and Orissa.

FUNGI

Daedalea flava Lev. 8486 Palaspal, 12349, 12353 Bhanjabasa, 12548, 12549 Simlipal, growing in a concentric manner on fallen log in a flowing stream.

Fomes pachyphaleus Pat. 12348 Bhanjabasa, forming successive stout masses on Sal tree; scarce.

F. senex Nees et Mont. 12442 Jenabil, on a living tree of *Eugenia*; common.

Fomes sp. 12443 Jenabil, woody mushroom on living trees; rare.

Geaster sp. 8555 Burhipada, in sandy forest floor; common.

Hexagonia apiaria Pers. 8495 Palaspal, on dead twig; scarce.

H. discopoda Pat. et Har. 8313 Sukinda, on the bark of dead twigs of trees; common.

H. sulcata Berk. 12603 Gopinathpur, asymmetrically growing in a line along dead log, lying across the river Palpala; common.

Hexagonia sp. 12692 Chahala, on dead log; scarce.

Hymenochaete sp. 12356 Bhanjabasa, 12551 Simlipalgarh, on dead log; frequent.

Lentinus praerigidus Berk. 12350 Lulung, stalked on dead log; frequent.

Lentinus sp. 8332 Sukinda, 8488 Palaspal, 8513 Palaspal, 8782 Malaygiri, on dead log; common.

Lycopordon sp. puffballs, 8385 Deogaon, on wet soil; frequent.

Polyporus arcularius Batch. & Fries. 12575 near Nigirda stream, on fallen twigs; scarce.

P. gilvus Schw. 12589 Burhabalang, on bark of log; occasional.

P. sulphureus (Bull) Fr. 8632 Bankura, on old tree trunk; rare.

Polyporus sp. 8514 Palaspal, on dead wood; frequent.

Polyporus sp. 8317 Sukinda, on dead trunk of a tree; frequent.

Polystictus cinnabarinus (Jacq.) Fr. 8316 Sukinda, on dead trunk of a tree; frequent.

P. pergamenus Fr. 12552 Simlipalgarh, on dead log; scarce.

P. sanguineus (Linn.) May. 8527 Palaspal, 12792 Kachudahan, on dead log; frequent.

P. labacinus Mont. 12590 Nigirda, on the bark of dead trees; scarce.

P. xanthopus Fr. 12355 Burhabalang, 12666 Barheipani, on dead log and twig in the moist floor; common.

Schizophyllum commune Fr. 12358 Lulung, on dead wood; frequent.

Trametes cingulata Berk. 12352 Bhanjabasa on dead log; scarce.

T. cubensis (Mont.) Sacc. 12604 Palpala river bank, on moist log lying near bank of a river; scarce.

Xylaria sp. 8487 Palaspal, on the sandy mound of white ants; frequent.
