

A CENSUS OF PALMS CULTIVATED IN THE INDIAN BOTANIC GARDEN, HOWRAH

ABSTRACT

This paper deals with the palms cultivated in the Indian Botanic Garden, Howrah. Altogether 109 species of palms have been enumerated from this garden of both economic and ornamental species. The accompanying map of the Garden will help in locating the different species of palms.

The Indian Botanic Garden, Howrah, situated near sea level (4.5 m alt.) in West Bengal. It comprises an area of 109.29 hectares, the approximate annual rainfall is 1536 mm and temperature ranges from 21°C to 31°C.

A population of more than 12000 plants is spread over the landscape. Among others, palm plays a dominant part in enhancing the beauty and scientific aspect of the garden.

The main object of bringing out this list of palms cultivated in the Indian Botanic Garden is to give an idea of the palm wealth of this garden after nearly two centuries of its existence. We get references of palm collection of this garden from the works of Griffith (1844), Gage (1912), Blatter (1926), Sen & Naskar (1965), Benthal (1946), Basu (1969). Blatter (1926) includes among others the history of introduction of *Lodoicea maldivica* the giant *Coco-de-mer* palm into this garden.

Many species which were earlier recorded have died, many of them replaced and at the same time many were newly introduced and established in the garden. With this continuous process many species are not found in their earlier mentioned localities and in many cases their previous names are

no longer in use. Therefore, an up-to-date census providing recent botanical names and synonyms, country of origin, their locations in the garden and habit were felt necessary. The existence of *Nypa fruticans* as mentioned in earlier records is no longer found in the Garden, but this beautiful estuarine palm is included in our list as it happens to grow luxuriantly at the Governor's residence Garden in Calcutta a few miles only from this garden on the other side of river Hooghly.


For preparing this list valuable guideline was taken from Moore Jr. (1963). The accompanying map of Indian Botanic Garden showing 25 working divisions corresponds to the division numbers mentioned at the bottom of each species to find their location.

The abbreviations used in this article are as follows:

DN=Divisions ; F=Flowering and fruiting ; C=Clustering ; S=Single stemmed ; P=Pinnate leaved ; PA=Palmate leaved ; NF=Not yet flowering ; PT=Potted plant ; LPH=Large Palm House ; SPH=Small Palm House ; OH=Orchid House ; N=Nursery No. 1 ; RB=River bank.


