

NEW SPECIES OF *SAXIFRAGA* FROM ARUNACHAL PRADESH, INDIA




Fig.1. *Saxifraga assamensis* Wadhwa : A. Habit; B. Leaf; C. Flower; D. Sepal; E. Petal; F. Carpel; G. Bract.

***Saxifraga assamensis* Wadhwa sp. nov. (Fig. 1)**

Ad sectionem *Ciliatae* Haw. pertinent, planta a *Saxifraga brachypoda* Don, axillis foliorum superiorum bulbills carentibus, a *Saxifraga gouldii* Fischer, marginibus petalorum pilis glanduliferis carentibus, a utraque pedicellis glabres, calyces extus glabrosed in dimidio distali margine pilis glanduliferis instructa differt. Saxifraga wardii W.W. Sm. floribus erectis nec nutantibus petalis elliptic, glandulosis marginibus calyce extus glabro differt.

Holotypus : Indiae: Arunachal Pradesh, 28° 15' N, 96° 40' E, 3600-3900 m., 1.10.1928, *F. Kingdon Ward* 8683 (K).

Plants caespitose, 20-26 cm tall, slender, glabrous, the basal 2-4 cm part almost naked, with remnants of old leaves, the upper profusely leafy. Leaves alternate, lax, linear-lanceolate, 6-12 mm long 1.3-1.4 mm wide, those of the middle part of stem longer than the rest, acute, margin spinulose, the spinules of upper leaves, gland-tipped, nerves 3, the lateral ones almost parallel to the mid-rib, upper surface bright green, the lower somewhat silvery sheen, atleast when dry. Inflorescence racemose. Flowers usually 2, sometimes 3, rarely one, 1.2 cm across, golden yellow; peduncle 2.4-2.8 cm long, glabrous. Bracts like leaves, but smaller. Sepals broadly ovate, 3 mm long, 2.2 mm wide, obtuse, glabrous, margin from apex to the middle part with stipitate glands. Petals elliptic, 7-8 mm long, 4.4-4.6 mm wide, without glands or hairs, 3-nerved, lateral nerves bifid. Stamens 10, c.1/2 the length of the petals. Ovary ovoid, 3.3 mm broad; styles 1.6 mm long, divaricate. Fruit ovoid. Seeds oblong, brown.

Fls.: Oct.

Distribution : India : Arunachal Pradesh, Endemic.

Habitat.: On rocks on open alpine slopes.
