NEW RECORD OF *DUTTAPHRYNUS MIZORAMENSIS* (MATHEW AND SEN, 2009) (AMPHIBIA: ANURA: BUFONIDAE) IN TRIPURA, INDIA

INTRODUCTION

The genus *Duttaphrynus* is represented by nineteen species in India (Frost, 2016). In North East India there are twelve species (Duttaphrynus himalayanus, D. kiphirensis, D. macrotis, D. mamitensis, D. manipurensis, D. melanostictus, D. mizoramensis, D. nagalandensis, D. scaber, D. stomaticus, D. stuarti and D. wokhaensis) under the same genus (Mathew & Sen, 2010). Mathew and Sen (2009) described Duttaphrynus mizoramensis from Mizoram. The authors came across a total of three specimens of Duttaphrynus mizoramensis from two lots collected from Tripura in the unidentified holding of NERC/ZSI, Shillong. Two specimens (V/A/ERS/ZSI/1202) were collected from Sonaichori Ramachandra Riangpara, Belonia, South Tripura Dist., Tripura (Alt. 24 meter, N: 23°15'34.0", E: 091°90'04.3", night collection)

and one specimen (V/A/ERS/ZSI/1204) was collected from Kalukura (residential area around the Circuit House), Kailashahar, North Tripura Dist., Tripura (Alt. 28 meter, N: 24°17′20.3″, E: 092° 01′56.0″). Both the specimen lots were collected in 2005. (Fig. 1&2)

These specimens were compared with the holotype of *Duttaphrynus mizoramensis* available at the holdings of NERC/ZSI, Shillong, for identification.

Occurrence of the above species in Tripura extends its range of distribution to this State.
